3. Discuss Issues in the County
- a. Ryan: After looking at this list the most common issues that people ask law enforcement for help with are alcohol and individual counseling. There are services here but the waiting list is too long.
 - b. Labriana: This issue occurs in a lot of rural communities. The risks and need assessment should happen as soon as they enter the detention center. That way the data is capture before people leave the system.
 - i. Judge Allen says that they have an assessment tool but that Labriana had a good idea about when to use it.

- ii. Christal says that these situations are reoccurring in a lot of situations because the victims are related to the aggressor and they are going back into the same living situation without receiving any counseling.
