1. Attendance

4. Committee Updates

a. Rio Arriba

Judge Lidyard:

- Lots of work since the mapping project last year. The Subcommittees have been changed to reflect the goals of the mapping project.
- Detox subcommittee and Darren's place are close to implementing their detox facility as was their goal.
 - Staffing still ongoing but otherwise ready
- Crisis Response for overdose calls.
 - Fire Department is working with group to combine efforts into a county wide program
- Peer Support
 - Rio Arriba Drug Court and Detention Facility looking to add peers for help with re-entry

b. Santa Fe

- Coy Maienza: Meeting pulling together some of the key players in the mapping session
 - Waiting for the actual map to come out
- Stacey Boone, AOC: AOC has received a report from the NCSC and will send out the report today or tomorrow.

c. Los Alamos

- Stacey Boone, AOC: looking at June 23-24th and working with Jessica to find a location and to build a stakeholder list.
- Krista Kelley:
 - Convening, sat down with Los Alamos and updated the committee members and have started to get good participation.
 - Reviewed the stakeholder that we need at the mapping session.
 - Identifying some areas of need and looking at priorities in order to help the group form subcommittee.

5. Update from Administrative Office of the Courts

- a. Assisted Outpatient Treatment - Stacey Boone, AOC: Gave overview of the AOT Statute including eligibility and limitations, who may file for AOT, what happens during and after the petition
- b. Competency – Stacey Boone, AOC: Looking at misdemeanor cases (not including DWI) and instead of dismissal off ramping into behavioral health and other services.
 - i. Voluntary program
 - ii. Based on case history
 - iii. Connects Defendant with navigator who will engage them in services
 - iv. 3-6 months long

6. Action Items

- a. Approval of New Mexico Sentencing Commission grant proposal.
 - i. Krista Kelley: There are three grant applications submitted to the Council to be reviewed and voted upon by the Council. Voting should be based upon priority.
 1. Kateri Eisenberg: Gave overview of FJDC grant request for \$118,000 (Grant 1). Grant will cover funding needed to contract CJCC Coordinator for second year and may include: Strategic Planning, onboarding process, website modifications, communications plan, data collection assistance.
 2. Julie Ball: Gave overview of LOPD grant request for \$50,000 (Grant 2). Grant will cover funding needed to implement Safe Surrender and Warrant Forgiveness program and may be used to cover: advertising campaigns, equipment, and refreshments.

3. Julie Ball: Gave overview of LOPD grant request for \$900 (Grant 3). Grant will cover funding needed to Bus Pass program and may be used to cover: 163 client bus passes.
 - ii. **Motion:** Julie Ball to approve all three applications with Grant 1 – first priority, Grant 2 – second priority, Grant 3 – third priority. **Second:** Judge Mascarenas. **Vote:** Passed Unanimously

- a. Krista Kelley asked if Stacey Boone could attend a subsequent meeting to further update the CJCC on AOT and Competency. Stacey Boone agreed.
