

Response to Questions — RFP #FJDC-2027-001

- Do we have to attend the weekly Adult Treatment Court hearings in-person or will it be virtual?
 - The Adult Treatment Court hearings are held in person, bi-weekly (currently, every other Friday).
- Will this program require DIMS system reporting? If so, what is the reporting frequency?
 - Yes, this program requires DIMS system reporting on a weekly basis.
- Does the Phase 1 - Minimum of 3 weekly contacts with Drug Court Office Weekly Drug Court appearances include the weekly MRT, group therapy, and individual therapy session?
 - The Drug Court Office does not participate in the weekly MRT, group therapy, and individual sessions. The 3 weekly contacts occur outside of these procedures.
- Is this Adult Treatment Program required to abide by the nationally established All Rise (formerly National Association of Drug Court Professionals) requirements?
 - Yes, the Adult Treatment Program is required to abide by the nationally established All Rise requirements.
- Are observed UA testing services required for this service? If so, will it require observed specimen collection with same gendered staff members? Is video monitoring acceptable?
 - Observed urine drug screens may be required and must be conducted by a staff member of the same gender as the participant. If the standard protocol causes severe discomfort or triggers trauma, other accommodations may be made to prioritize participant safety and dignity. Video monitoring of urine drug screens is not acceptable.
- Are there reporting requirements attached to fee-for-service for service billed to Medicaid?
 - It is required that the provider be Medicaid certified at the time of award. The provider will be required to bill Medicaid primarily for screening assessments and all other services that qualify. The provider must provide the explanation of benefits (EOB) for each participant that is billed to Medicaid, Medicare or any private insurance if there is a formal denial that has exhausted all options of resubmission for payment. The court will be the payer of last resort and can be billed via monthly invoice with the proper EOB attached as evidence of final denial.
- Is this contract set up as a service case rate billing or flat fee monthly billing?
 - The contract will be set up as a flat fee monthly billing.
- What is the maximum contract award amount?
 - The maximum contract award amount is \$60,000 per year.
